

Pacman Dishcloths

A complete set comprises:

Pacman – yellow

Blinky – red ghost

Pinky – pink ghost

Inky – blue ghost

Clyde – orange ghost

Materials:

Yarn: Dishcloth cotton e.g. Sugar'n Cream, Peaches and Crème, or other aran weight cotton.

(I used Sugar'n Cream for Inky (blue) and Clyde (orange), Tivoli Cruise Aran for Blinky (red), and Patons Cotton DK held double for Pacman – these are the yarns I had in my stash and without ready access to shops selling dishcloth cotton)

Each dishcloth took about 35g of yarn.

Needles: 4.5mm (US 7)

Gauge: Not really important

Finishing: Block as desired – I found that dampening slightly and pressing with a hot iron worked nicely with the cotton yarn.

Instructions are given as a chart or written for each dishcloth.

A note on copyright: Obviously the Pacman images are copyrighted, and not by me. If you're here about that, of course I'll take the patterns down right away. If you're here to make a dishcloth please just be using this to make dishcloths – for yourself, or to give away. Please don't sell them or pass the pattern off as your own. Thanks.

Now, enjoy chasing your dirty dishes around the place, and eating that cherry pie for authenticity in washing up!

Ghost - Chart

Cast on 35 stitches. Work chart as follows. Bind off and sew in ends.

	Knit on right side, Purl on wrong side
•	Purl on right side, Knit on wrong side

Ghost - Written

Cast on 35 stitches and work as follows:
